Dues & Training Fund Remittance Summary for Contractors

WORKING DUES

Working dues are assessed at **4% of gross wages**. These dues must be remitted to UA Local Union 41 on a **monthly basis**, no later than the **20th of each month**.

BASE DUES

Base dues are currently **\$41.00 per month per member** for Journeymen and Apprentices. Base dues may be handled in one of the following ways:

- The contractor may set up **automatic payroll deduction** and remit base dues to UA Local Union 41 along with working dues, or
- Individual members may remit their base dues directly to UA Local Union 41 on a monthly basis.

Please advise UA Local Union 41 how you intend to administer base dues. If the contractor elects to remit base dues, a designated line is provided on the monthly remittance form.

Metal Trade Production Workers: Base dues are **\$41.00 per month** and are automatically deducted from the employee's 4% working dues once received from the contractor.

APPRENTICESHIP & JOURNEYMAN TRAINING FUND (JATC)

In addition to the 4% working dues, contractors are required to submit a **separate check** payable to the **Silver Bow Apprenticeship & Journeyman Training Committee (JATC)** for training fund contributions. Contribution rates are as follows:

- Journeyman: **\$1.37 per hour**
- Production Worker: **\$0.30 per hour**
- Apprentice: **\$0.00 per hour**

All dues and training fund contributions are required under the applicable Collective Bargaining Agreement with UA Local Union 41.
